NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Person-to-Person/Place-to-Place Transfer of Plenary Retail Consumption License No. 1814-33-004-003** – D.M.S. Mr. Phoenix explained that this resolution authorizes a personto-person transfer of the plenary retail consumption license from 164 Somerset Street, L.L.C. to Toson Food & Beverages North Plainfield LLC, a New Jersey limited liability company d/b/a Arooga's Grille House and Sports Bar. The purchaser has applied to have the license transferred to it as a "pocket" license, he concluded.

2. Award of Bid for Somerset/Pearl Street Parking Lot Project – D.E.H. Mr. Hollod explained that this resolution authorizes the award of the bid for construction of the Somerset and Pearl Street Parking Lot projects to Your Way Construction, Inc.

3. **Resolution Authorizing an Agreement with Keane Construction, LLC for Renovations to the Upstairs Conference Room and Hallway** – D.E.H. Mr. Hollod advised that this resolution authorizes the award of the bid for rehabilitation of the upstairs conference room and hallway to Keane Construction, LLC.

4. **Resolution Authorizing an Agreement with Somerset County for the FY 2016-2017 Municipal Alliance Grant** – D.E.H. Mr. Hollod explained that this resolution authorizes an agreement with Somerset County for \$15,459.02 to the Borough of North Plainfield for municipal alliance activities in the prevention of alcoholism and drug abuse.

5. **Ordinance Reconfiguring Loading Zone on Harmony Street** – D.E.H. Mr. Hollod explained that this ordinance amends the limits within the zone and preserves parking spaces.

6. **Ordinance Modifying Fire Prevention Fees** – D.E.H. Mr. Hollod advised that these ordinances allow for an update of the fees within the Fire Department.

7. **Resolution Authorizing an Agreement with Barnickel Engineering Corp. for Study of HVAC System at Borough Hall** – D.E.H. Mr. Hollod explained that this resolution authorizes Barnickel Engineering Corp. to provide certain professional engineering services associated with the Study and Report of existing HVAC systems within the firefighters' living and sleeping quarters.
