RESOLUTION NO. 05-22-17-03a RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH CLERK TO EXECUTE CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER REQUEST NO. 2 AMENDING THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH SUBURBAN CONSULTING ENGINEERS INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE PROPOSED FUELING FACILITY AT THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS PROPERTY FOR THE BOROUGH OF NORTH PLAINFIELD

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, awarded a contract for Professional Engineering Services to Suburban Consulting Engineers, Inc., with a principal place of business located at 96 U.S. Highway 206, Suite 101, Flanders, New Jersey 07836 (hereinafter referred to as "SCE"), and authorized the Mayor and the Borough Clerk to execute a contract with SCE on behalf of the Borough, with respect to the proposed fueling facility at the Department of Public Works Property; and,

WHEREAS, SCE, by letter dated April 18, 2017, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the Borough Clerk and made a part hereof, has requested "Change Order Request No. 2" to amend the professional services contract for the design services of the fueling facility requesting the following additions for a lump sum payment of Fourteen Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$14,400.00):

- Preparation of Construction Plans & Specifications for Underground Storage Tanks for Fueling Station (Original design was for the relocation of the Existing Aboveground Storage Tank and Fueling Station Design);
- Additional Permitting Review for Underground Storage Tank Installation; and,
- Coordination for field changes of new generator.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the Borough Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and the Borough Clerk, on behalf of the Borough, to sign and/or execute Change Order Request No. 2, dated April 18, 2017, with Suburban Consulting Engineers, Inc. which Change Order Request is incorporated herein by reference as if same was fully set forth, without the need for any further action of this Borough Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award of this Change Order Request No. 2 shall be subject to the Certification of the Borough's Chief Financial Officer as to the availability of funds for payment for same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award is made pursuant to and consistent with the Local Public Contracts Laws of the State of New Jersey.

RESOLUTION NO. 05-22-17-04 SUPPORTING THE CLICK IT OR TICKET MOBILIZATION OF MAY 22 - JUNE 4,2017

Whereas, there were 604 motor vehicle fatalities in New Jersey in 2016; and

Whereas, a large percentage of the motor vehicle occupants killed in traffic crashes were not wearing a seat belt; and

Whereas, use of a seat belt remains the most effective way to avoid death or serious injury in a motor vehicle crash; and

Whereas, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration estimates that 135,000 lives were saved by safety belt usage nationally between 1975-2000; and

Whereas, the State of New Jersey will participate in the nationwide Click It or Ticket seat belt mobilization from May 22 – June 4, 2017 in an effort to raise awareness and increase seat belt usage through a combination of high visibility enforcement and public education; and

Whereas, the Division of Highway Traffic Safety has set a goal of increasing the seat belt usage rate in the state from the current level of 93% to 95%; and

Whereas, a further increase in seat belt usage in New Jersey will save lives on our roadways;

Therefore, be it resolved that the Borough of North Plainfield declares its support for the Click It or Ticket seat belt mobilization both locally and nationally from May 22 – June 4, 2017 and pledges to increase awareness of the mobilization and the benefits of seat belt use.
