The Council President read the following Notice of Compliance:

NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Mott MacDonald – Extension of General Sewer Engineering Services Contract** –D.E.H. Mr. Hollod explained that two main tasks were involved including closeout for sewer projects and primary design services for the West End project. The closeout will be reflected by a Resolution at the December 11th meeting.

2. **Exempt Salaries** – M.G. As Mr. Hollod's salary is part of the salary resolution, Mayor Giordano discussed exempt salaries, and advised that the exempt employees had not received a raise in 2016. The amounts in the resolution reflect a 3% increase retro to January 1, 2017. Replying to the Council President, the Mayor explained that the two Recreation assistants would each be receiving the increase.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Frank N. D'Amore Sr., 40 Willow Avenue, North Plainfield, recalled that at the November 13th Council Meeting, he had opposed Sanctuary State status for New Jersey since it would violate the Council's sworn office.
