RESOLUTION NO. 02-13-18-05a RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A TREATMENT WORKS APPROVAL PERMIT APPLICATION BY THE BOROUGH OF NORTH PLAINFIELD FOR THE QUICKCHEK CONVENIENCE STORE WITH FUEL FILLING STATION AND CANOPY PROJECT

WHEREAS, Coremark No. Plainfield, LLC, is planning to install a sanitary sewer main extension and a new sanitary sewer service lateral along Maple Avenue to allow for the construction of a QuickChek convenience store with fuel filling station and canopy (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"); and,

WHEREAS, Coremark No. Plainfield, LLC, must make an application for a Treatment Works Approval ("TWA") Permit from the New Jersey State Department of Environmental Protection for the Project (hereinafter referred to as the "Application"); and,

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection requires a Statement of Consent from the municipality in which a project is located as part of the Treatment Works Approval Permit process; and,

WHEREAS, as the Project is located within the Borough of North Plainfield, the Borough must give its consent to obtain a Treatment Works Approval (TWA) Permit and the Project to go forward; and,

WHEREAS, as the Borough of North Plainfield will be the eventual owner of the proposed sanitary sewer main extension, as part of the Application, it must identify itself as the Applicant/Owner; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield must name an agent in all matters pertaining to the Application; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield believes it is in the best interest of the Borough to name Jeffrey A. Martell of Stonefield Engineering & Design, LLC, with offices located at 92 Park Avenue, Rutherford, New Jersey 07070, the design engineer on the Project, as its agent in all matters pertaining to the Application; and,

WHEREAS, as part of the Application, the Borough of North Plainfield must agree that the Project will be properly constructed and operated in accordance with the engineering plans, specifications and conditions under which approval is granted by the New Jersey State Department of Environmental Protection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield that the Borough of North Plainfield hereby grants its consent to submit a Treatment Works Approval (TWA) Permit Application to the New Jersey State Department of Environmental Protection for the Project and hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Statement of Consent form identifying the Borough as the Applicant/Owner, naming Jeffrey A. Martell of Stonefield Engineering & Design, LLC as its agent in all matters pertaining to the Application, agreeing that the Project will be properly constructed and operated in accordance with the engineering plans, specifications and conditions under which approval is granted by the New Jersey State Department of Environmental Protection and any and all other necessary documents to complete the Application.

RESOLUTION NO. 02-13-18-05b WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield desires to authorize the sale of various surplus equipment no longer in use by the Borough at public sale pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40A:11-36 to the highest bidder;

- 1. The Borough of North Plainfield hereby declares that the above-described surplus equipment is no longer needed for public use.
- 2. The Borough of North Plainfield, its officers and attorney are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all steps necessary to proceed with a public sale of said surplus equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Police Department be and hereby is authorized and directed to sell said surplus equipment at a public auction to be held at Police Headquarters commencing April 7, 2018; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any monies received as a result of said auction shall be paid into the general municipal treasury in accordance with the provisions of *N.J.S.A.* 40A:11-36; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Clerk shall cause a notice of said auction, designating the time and place therefore, to be published in an official newspaper of the Borough not less than 10 days prior to the date of said public auction.

RESOLUTION NO. 02-13-18-05c SAFE AND SECURE COMMUNITIES PROGRAM

RESOLUTION OF PARTICIPATION AND ACCEPTANCE

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT FROM THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY FEDERAL GRANT PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE, DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY.

Whereas, the Borough of North Plainfield does accept funding of \$90,000 with a match of \$400,785 for an approximate project total cost of \$490,785 for a project under the State of New Jersey Safe and Secure Neighborhoods Grant Program, Subaward number: P-18-1814, with a subaward award period of March 1, 2018 to February 28, 2019, and

Whereas, the North Plainfield Borough Council does accept the grant Subaward funding for assisting with paying the base salary of police officers, and

Whereas, the project is a joint effort between the Department of Law and Public Safety and the Borough of North Plainfield for the purpose described in the application;

Therefore, be it resolved by the North Plainfield Borough Council that

- 1. As a matter of public policy, the Borough of North Plainfield wishes to accept grant funding to the fullest extent possible with the Department of Law and Public Safety.
- 2. The Attorney General will receive funds on behalf of the applicant.

- 3. The Division of Criminal Justice shall be responsible for the receipt and review of the application for said funds.
- 4. The Division of Criminal Justice shall initiate allocations to each applicant as authorized.
