**RESOLUTION NO. 02-26-18-03c** RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH CLERK TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH TAYLOR ARCHITECTURE & DESIGN FOR ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES FOR THE DESIGN OF THE NEW EXTERIOR ENTRANCE RAMP FOR THE NORTH PLAINFIELD MEMORIAL LIBRARY IN THE BOROUGH OF NORTH PLAINFIELD

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield is in need of certain architectural services for the new exterior entrance ramp for the North Plainfield Memorial Library (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"); and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield solicited proposals for the Project and received a proposal from Taylor Architecture & Design.

WHEREAS, the Director of Law/Borough Attorney, Eric M. Bernstein, Esq. and the offices of Eric M. Bernstein & Associates, L.L.C., have reviewed the proposal and recommend that the Project be granted to Taylor Architecture & Design, whose main offices are located at 95 Watchung Avenue, North Plainfield, New Jersey 07060 (hereinafter referred to as the "Architect"); and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield is desirous of obtaining the services of the Architect to perform all those services contemplated by the request for proposals; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the Borough Council hereby accepts the following Proposal, a copy of said proposal being maintained in the Office of the Borough Clerk, and the contents of which are incorporated herein:

# **REQUESTS FOR AGENDA ITEMS:**

Mr. Hollod advised that the budget would be discussed and introduced at the next meeting. A cap bank ordinance would also be introduced.

#### **PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Frank D'Amore, Sr., 40 Willow Avenue, North Plainfield, voiced his concerns with the lack of maintenance on the obelisk street markers in town. Mr. Hollod advised that all of the obelisk street markers would be replaced with conventional poles by the end of the year.

## COMMENTS BY MAYOR, ADMINISTRATOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS:

Mr. Hollod commented that the Black History event at the high school was well attended despite poor weather conditions. The main floor of the library remains closed for renovations. New Jersey American Water expects to complete the replacement of water meters on Clinton Avenue by the end of March.

Mr. Merrill reported on the well-written letter issued by Superintendent Michelle Vella about our school safety program. The North Plainfield Junior Canucks are now the Lumberjacks. Five bands are booked for the summertime concert series and they would like to add a Latin American band for the downtown. Tom Allen is the new Parks and Recreation Committee Chair, he concluded.

Mr. Phoenix, in the absence of Councilwoman Miller, added that the Black History event had also been broadcast live by WKMB Radio at the encouragement of Ms. Miller and the Clerk's Office. Their coverage was greatly appreciated. The station now maintains offices and studios in North Plainfield.

Motion to adjourn by Mr. Stabile, seconded by Mr. Merrill and carried unanimously.
