## **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. **2018** Capital Items (Anticipated Bond Ordinance Introduction, Hearing and Adoption) – D.E.H. Mr. Hollod explained this is an annual procedure for projects with an extended useful life such as sewer repairs, library renovations and roadway improvements.

2. Ordinance to Amend, Revise and Supplement the Various Portions of the Borough Code of the Borough of North Plainfield to Adjust Various Fees and Penalties and Related Matters – D.E.H. Mr. Hollod advised that this ordinance will raise various fees and penalties for several different departments within the Borough.

## REPORTS OF BOARDS, COMMITTEES, COMMISSIONS:

Reporting on the State Department of Education's proposal for a joint Charter School Votech program for North Plainfield and Plainfield, Mr. Merrill indicated that both superintendents opposed same. The Board of Education budget reflects a nine percent increase in State funds and the typical household in North Plainfield should see a decrease in the taxes of approximately \$87.14, he concluded.
