RESOLUTION NO. 05-14-18-02d RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH PLAINFIELD APPOINTING KATHLEEN INTRAVARTOLO AS THE QUALIFIED PURCHASING AGENT FOR THE BOROUGH OF NORTH PLAINFIELD AND INCREASING THE BID THRESHOLD FOR THE BOROUGH OF NORTH PLAINFIELD

WHEREAS, <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 5:34-5.4 authorizes a municipality by resolution to appoint a qualified purchasing agent who meets certain eligibility criteria; and,

WHEREAS, <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 5:34-5.4 authorizes a municipality to increase its bid threshold for a qualified purchasing agent by adopting a resolution increasing its bid threshold to Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000); and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield has determined that Kathleen Intravartolo meets all of the eligibility criteria set forth in <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 5:34-5.4 to be appointed as the qualified purchasing agent; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield wishes to appoint Kathleen Intravartolo as qualified purchasing agent for the Borough of North Plainfield and increase its bid threshold to Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000); and,

WHEREAS, Kathleen Intravartolo has provided to the Borough an Affidavit of QPA Qualification in order to qualify for the provisions of this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that Kathleen Intravartolo is hereby appointed as

Qualified Purchasing Agent for the Borough of North Plainfield effective May 8, 2018, and the bid threshold for the Borough of North Plainfield is hereby increased to Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000).

RESOLUTION NO. 05-14-18-02e ALTERNATE MUNICIPAL PROSECUTOR COMPENSATION FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2018

WHEREAS, the Borough previously appointed Benjamin Zilbergeld, Esq. as the Borough's Alternate Municipal Prosecutor for calendar year 2018 and to compensate him for such services on a per session basis; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that Benjamin Zilbergeld, Esq. shall be compensated by salary to serve as Alternate Municipal Prosecutor in the amount of Five Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$5,200.00), which shall be paid from the Municipal Prosecutor's salary account, retroactive to January 1, 2018. All other compensation arrangements for said position previously approved are voided, retroactive to January 1, 2018.
