WHEREAS, because of the late adoption of the New Jersey State Budget and calculation of the Tax Rate by the County Board of Taxation and the corresponding late printing of the tax bills, third quarter tax bills will not be mailed by the deadline of July 17, 2018; and

WHEREAS, THE Borough Council believes that the residents of the Borough are entitled to a reasonable time to receive their tax bills for the third quarter and to pay the same without being delinquent and subject to the payment of interest; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that pursuant to N.J.S. 54:4-66.5 interest at a rate of \$.0000001% shall be charged on unpaid third quarter 2018 taxes provided same are paid on or before August 22, 2018, and provided further that interest thereafter shall be payable at the rate of 8% per annum on the first \$1,500.00 of the delinquency and 18% per annum on any amount in excess of \$1,500.00 to be calculated from August 1, 2018 until the date of actual payment.

## **PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Christine Holman, 21 Myrtle Avenue, North Plainfield, commented on the limebike program, stating that bikes had been left on her lawn. She suggested the use of bike stations as a way to control the issue. Ms. Schaefer interjected that the bikes are self-docking and they have a phone number on them which may be used to have them picked up.

Frank D'Amore, 40 Willow Avenue, North Plainfield, again urged the Council to go on record in opposition to Governor Murphy's legislation regarding recreational marijuana. Council President La Ronde confirmed that they would look into it.

#### COMMENTS BY MAYOR, ADMINISTRATOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS:

Speaking on behalf of Mayor Giordano, Mr. Hollod reported that the Fourth of July parade and community day were well attended. The outdoor concerts at Vermeule have begun. An immigration forum will be held in September. The Car Nutz Car Cruise was well attended. Library events are now posted on the Borough website. National Night Out will be held Tuesday, August 7. The condition of the athletic fields would be discussed with Dave Testa. Regarding the keeping of animals, Mr. Hollod indicated that the procedure involves going before the Board of Health to obtain their approval. Advising that the ordinance doesn't provide much guidance, he reported that the Registrar would look at how neighboring towns deal with it. Ms. Schaefer added that large animals are a one-time fee. Mr. Hollod advised that other towns consider the lot size as well.

Mr. Bernstein advised that the subject line of the Executive Session resolution should be amended to read "Attorney/Client Privilege." Council indicated its agreement.
