RESOLUTION NO. 01-14-19-02a RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH PLAINFIELD APPOINTING A LICENSED SEWER OPERATOR

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield is in need of a professional to act as the Borough's C-3 Sanitary Sewer Operator for the 2019 calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to retain the services of David Hopkins of Mott MacDonald to act as the Borough's C-3 Sanitary Sewer Operator and believes that David Hopkins is eminently qualified to perform such engineering services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that David Hopkins of Mott MacDonald is hereby appointed as the Borough's C-3 Sanitary Sewer Operator for the 2019 calendar year.

RESOLUTION NO. 01-14-19-02b RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF THE BOROUGH'S SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE PLAINFIELD MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY FOR THE DISPOSAL OF TYPE 10 SOLID WASTE FROM THE BOROUGH OF NORTH PLAINFIELD

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield and the Plainfield Municipal Utilities Authority are currently parties to a Shared Services Agreement, authorized under the Shared Services and Consolidation Act, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:65-1 <u>et. seq.</u>, for the removal and disposal of Type 10 Waste from the Borough of North Plainfield; and,

WHEREAS, the current Shared Services Agreement is set to expire on March 31, 2019; and,

WHEREAS, the Plainfield Municipal Utilities Authority has expressed an interest in renewing the current Shared Services Agreement for an additional one (1) year term, with the current pricing not to change during said additional one (1) year term and subject to the same terms and conditions as set forth in the current Shared Services Agreement between the parties; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield is desirous of renewing the Shared Services Agreement with the Plainfield Municipal Utilities Authority for the removal and disposal of its Type 10 Waste from the Borough of North Plainfield for an additional one (1) year term, based upon the terms and conditions as set forth above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, that the Borough Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and the Borough Clerk on behalf of the Borough, to sign and/or execute the documents necessary to effectuate the one (1) year renewal of its current Shared Services Agreement with the Plainfield Municipal Utilities Authority for removal and disposal of Type 10 Waste from within the

Borough of North Plainfield, which Shared Services Agreement is incorporated herein by reference as if same was fully set forth, without the need for any further action of this Borough Council.

RESOLUTION NO. 01-14-19-02e RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH CLERK TO EXECUTE CERTAIN AGREEMENTS WITH LIME ENERGY FOR ENERGY EFFICIENCY IMPROVEMENTS AT BOROUGH HALL AND VERMEULE COMMUNITY CENTER FOR THE BOROUGH OF NORTH PLAINFIELD WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield is looking to increase energy efficiency at Borough Hall and at the Vermeule Community Center; and,

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey will fund a significant portion of the cost of the installation of energy efficiency improvements through the New Jersey Clean Energy Direct Install Program (hereinafter referred to as the "State Program"); and,

WHEREAS, Lime Energy, with its principal place of business located at 4 Gateway Center, 4th Floor, 100 Mulberry Street, Newark, New Jersey 07102, is in the business of installing energy efficiency improvements and has submitted two (2) proposals with associated agreements for the installation of certain energy efficiency improvements at Borough Hall and at the Vermeule Community Center, all of which are contemplated and set forth in the afore-referenced proposals and agreements, copies of said proposals and agreements being maintained in the Office of the Borough Clerk, and the contents of which are incorporated herein (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreements"); and,

WHEREAS, the Agreements submitted by Lime Energy all contemplate the installation of energy efficiency improvements to partially be funded through the State Program; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield is desirous of obtaining the services of Lime Energy to perform all of those improvements contemplated in the afore-referenced Agreements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the Borough Council does hereby authorize the Mayor and the Borough Clerk to sign and/or execute all of the necessary Agreements with Lime Energy, 4 Gateway Center, 4th Floor, 100 Mulberry Street, Newark, New Jersey 07102, as contemplated in the afore-referenced Agreements, for the installation of energy efficiency improvements at Borough Hall and Vermeule Community Center without the need for any further action of this Borough Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award of this Contract shall be subject to the Certification of the Borough's Chief Financial Officer as to the availability of funds for payment for same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award is made pursuant to and consistent with the Local Public Contracts Laws of the State of New Jersey.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Frank D'Amore, 40 Willow Avenue, North Plainfield, reported that thirty-six municipalities had opposed the Governor's legalization of marijuana. He questioned the status of the Borough's ordinance opposing marijuana. Council President Stabile advised that the ordinance had been tabled as they favored waiting for the State's legislation.

COMMENTS BY MAYOR, ADMINISTRATOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS

Mr. Hollod explained that those municipalities in opposition to the legalization of marijuana may find that their ordinances lack the required language after the State adopts their legislation. He

announced that the Department of Public Works would continue to pick up Christmas trees through the end of January. Yoga and Zumba classes would be held at the Community Center. The Police Department will host a free seminar for North Plainfield residents about active shooter scenarios on February 5, 2019 at the North Plainfield Community Center, he concluded.

Reporting that local food banks typically run low on canned and dry food after the holiday season, Mr. La Ronde urged everyone to consider making a donation, particularly now when supermarket chains were offering discounts on canned goods.

Motion to adjourn by Mr. La Ronde, seconded by Ms. Miller and on voice vote carried unanimously.
