**RESOLUTION NO. 10-21-19-02a** RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL APPROVING PAYMENT NO. TWO (FINAL) TO S. BROTHERS, INC., CHANGE WORK ORDER NO. ONE AND THE CLOSING OUT OF THE CONTRACT AND RELEASE OF RETAINAGE FOR THE PROJECT KNOWN AS THE SANDFORD AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS – NJDOT 2017

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield previously awarded a contract for certain road improvements with regard to a project known as the "Sandford Avenue Improvements" project (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"), with said contract having been awarded to S. Brothers Inc. whose main offices are located in South River, New Jersey 08882 (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor"); and,

WHEREAS, David J. Testa, P.E., C.M.E., C.P.W.M. of Grotto Engineering and Associates, LLC (hereinafter referred to as the "Engineer"), on behalf of the Borough, by letter dated September 23, 2019, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the Borough Clerk and made a part hereof, has reviewed the Contractor's submission for Payment No. 2 (Final) in the total amount of Twenty Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars and Eighty-Two Cents (\$20,935.82), plus the release of any and all of the Contractor's retained funds held by the Borough for the Project; and,

WHEREAS, the Engineer, on behalf of the Borough, by letter dated September 23, 2019, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the Borough Clerk and made a part hereof, has requested "Change Order Request No. 1" to amend the professional services contract for the Project modifying the services and materials, with a reduction of Eleven Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Dollars and Forty-Five Cents (\$11,360.45); and,

WHEREAS, Director of Law/Borough Attorney Eric M. Bernstein, Esq. and the offices of Eric M. Bernstein & Associates, L.L.C. has reviewed the Engineer's and the Contractor's submissions and accepts same based on the recommendations of the Engineer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the request for Partial Payment No. 2 (Final), dated August 23, 2019, and the Closeout of the Project known as the Sandford Avenue Improvements – NJDOT 2017, is approved with S. Brothers, Inc. whose main offices are located in South River, New Jersey 08882, in the total amount of Twenty Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars and Eighty-Two Cents (\$20,935.82), plus the release of any and all of the Contractor's retained funds held by the Borough for the Project, which Final Payment Request and Closeout request is incorporated herein by reference as if same was fully set forth within and payment for same is authorized to be made to the Contractor, without the need for any further action of this Borough Council; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the Borough Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and the Borough Clerk, on behalf of the Borough, to sign and/or execute Change Order Request No. 1, dated August 28, 2019, with S. Brothers, Inc., which Change Order Request No. 1 is incorporated herein by reference as if same was fully set forth, without the need for any further action of this Borough Council

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be subject to the Certification of the Borough's Chief Financial Officer as to the availability of funds for payment for same; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and the Borough Clerk to sign and/or execute all necessary documents to close out the Project and issue Payment No. 2 (Final).

**RESOLUTION NO. 10-21-19-02b** RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL ADOPTING AN UPDATED EDITION OF THE EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH PLAINFIELD

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield is in need of adopting a reviewed and revised edition of the Borough's employee handbook to provide guidelines for Borough employees; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield's Administration, with the aid of the Borough's Attorney, has reviewed and revised the Employee Handbook where appropriate; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council are desirous to adopt the revised edition of the Employee Handbook as the official employee handbook to provide guidelines for the employees of the Borough of North Plainfield, subject to applicable collective bargaining agreements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the Borough Council does hereby adopt the revised edition of the Borough of North Plainfield Employee Handbook as the official handbook of the Borough of North Plainfield to provide guidelines for Borough employees with the understanding that the <a href="handbook is not a contract of employment and is further subject to all applicable collective bargaining agreements">handbook is not a contract of employment and is further subject to all applicable collective bargaining agreements.</a>

**RESOLUTION NO. 10-21-19-02c** RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CERTIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE UNITED STATES EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY COMMISSION'S "ENFORCEMENT GUIDANCE ON THE CONSIDERATION OF ARREST AND CONVICTION RECORDS IN EMPLOYMENT DECISIONS UNDER TITLE VII OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964"

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-5, as amended by P.L. 2017, c. 183, requires the governing body of each municipality and county to certify that their local unit's hiring practices comply with the United States Equal Employment Opportunity Commission's "Enforcement Guidance on the Consideration of Arrest and Conviction Records in Employment Decisions Under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964," as amended, 42 U.S.C. § 2000e *et seq.*, (April 25, 2012) before submitting its approved annual budget to the Division of Local Government Services of the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs; and,

WHEREAS, the members of the Borough Council have familiarized themselves with the contents of the above-referenced enforcement guidance and with the Borough's hiring practices as they pertain to the consideration of an individual's criminal history, as evidenced by the group affidavit form of the governing body attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield hereby states that it has complied with N.J.S.A. 40A:4-5, as amended by P.L. 2017, c.183, by certifying that the local unit's hiring practices comply with the above-referenced enforcement guidance and hereby directs the Clerk to cause to be maintained and available for inspection a certified copy of this resolution and the required affidavit to show evidence of said compliance.

**RESOLUTION NO. 10-21-19-02d** WHEREAS, the North Plainfield Conference St. Vincent de Paul Society, 99 Westervelt Avenue, North Plainfield, New Jersey, has applied for a license to conduct an off-premises 50-50 cash draw raffle on December 22, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Society has been issued Identification No. 352-3-42606 by the New Jersey Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission; and

WHEREAS, investigation has shown that said applicant meets the requirements for the issuance of a raffle license;
