WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield is in need of a professional to act as the Borough's C-4 Sanitary Sewer Operator for the 2020 calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to retain the services of Joseph Aidukas of Mott MacDonald to act as the Borough's C-4 Sanitary Sewer Operator and believes that Joseph Aidukas is eminently qualified to perform such engineering services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that Joseph Aidukas of Mott MacDonald is hereby appointed as the Borough's C-4 Sanitary Sewer Operator for the 2020 calendar year.

RESOLUTION NO. 01-27-20-02c RESOLUTION APPOINTING MUNICIPAL COURT PROSECUTOR AND ALTERNATE MUNICIPAL COURT PROSECUTOR TO THE NORTH PLAINFIELD MUNICIPAL COURT FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2020

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council on January 13, 2020 appointed Eric M. Bernstein & Associates, L.L.C. as Municipal Court Prosecutor to the North Plainfield Municipal Court for calendar year 2020; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Law/Borough Attorney and the Mayor wish to make changes in said designation, effective February 1, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that, as of February 1, 2020, the Municipal Court Prosecutor and Alternate Municipal Court Prosecutor to the North Plainfield Municipal Court, as well as Conflict Prosecutor for calendar year 2020 shall be as follows:

<u>Municipal Court Prosecutor</u>: Raymond J. Stine, Esq. of Shain Schaffer P.C. Mr. Stine shall be compensated at an annual salary of \$30,000.00, less all applicable deductions pro-rated from February 1, 2020.

<u>Alternate Municipal Court Prosecutor</u>: Franklin G. Whittlesey, Esq. of Scholl Whittlesey & Gruenberg L.L.C. Mr. Whittlesey shall be compensated at an annual salary of \$10,000.00, less all applicable deductions pro-rated from February 1, 2020.

<u>Conflict Prosecutor</u>: Eric M. Bernstein & Associates, L.L.C., effective February 1, 2020 with compensation to be paid at the Firm's hourly rate for other Borough work.

Messrs. Stine and Whittlesey shall remain in their respective positions until a successor for each is qualified and appointed.

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield has applied for a grant titled Emergency Management Agency Assistance (FY19-EMPG-EMAA-1814) in the amount of \$10,000.00;

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield has been granted a subaward (CFDA#: 97.042) for the performance period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of North Plainfield, in the County of Somerset, New Jersey, hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget of the year 2020; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the subgrant, consisting of a total amount of up to \$20,757.46, including up to \$10,000.00 Federal Award and up to \$10,747.46 Local Matching Funds is for the purpose of enhancing the Borough of North Plainfield's ability to prevent, protect against, respond to and recover from acts of terrorism, natural disasters and other catastrophic events and emergencies; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that these funds will be used for the purposes of salary, wages and fringe benefits for the staffing of the Office of Emergency Management; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough of North Plainfield does accept the Subaward, and authorizes Brian L Martin, the Coordinator of the Office of Emergency Management to execute all documents related to this grant program.
