RESOLUTION NO. 02-24-20-01a RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH CLERK TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SOMERSET FOR A CERTIFIED RECYCLING PROFESSIONAL TO SIGN ANNUAL RECYCLING TONNAGE REPORTS FOR THE BOROUGH OF NORTH PLAINFIELD

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield has duly enacted a recycling plan for all recyclable materials as designated by the Somerset County Solid Waste Management Plan and amendments thereto codified in the Borough Code under section 14-7, "Recycling Program" and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Recycling Enhancement Act, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 13:1E-96.2 <u>et seq.</u>, the Borough of North Plainfield is in need of a Certified Recycling Professional to approve and sign a mandatory Annual Recycling Tonnage Report to be submitted to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Somerset, a body politic having its offices located at 20 Grove Street, P.O. Box 3000, Somerville, New Jersey 08876 (hereinafter referred to as the "County"), has a Certified Recycling Professional on staff; and,

WHEREAS, while it is understood that the responsibility for the accuracy of all tonnage and materials reported lies with the Borough of North Plainfield, the Borough is desirous of retaining the services of the County's Certified Recycling Professional for the signing of said Annual Recycling Tonnage Report to be submitted to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection at a rate of Forty One Dollars and Eighty-Two Cents (\$41.82) per hour as needed, not to exceed an annual amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, that the Borough Council does hereby authorize the Mayor and Borough Clerk to enter into said contract with the County of Somerset, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, for the services of the County's Certified Recycling Professional to sign the Borough's Annual Recycling Tonnage Reports at a rate of Forty One Dollars and Eighty-Two Cents (\$41.82) per hour as needed, not to exceed an annual amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents on behalf of the Borough to effectuate this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the execution of this Contract shall be subject to the Certification of the Borough's Chief Financial Officer as to the availability of funds for payment for same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award of this contract to Somerset County, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 13:1E-99.14, is an exception to the bidding requirements as set forth in the Local Public Contracts Law of the State of New Jersey, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:11-5(2).

RESOLUTION NO. 02-24-20-01b RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL APPROVING PAYMENT NO. 3 (FINAL) TO S. BROTHERS, INC. AND THE CLOSING OUT OF THE CONTRACT AND RELEASE OF RETAINAGE FOR THE PROJECT KNOWN AS THE 2019 CAPITAL ROAD IMPROVEMENTS – VARIOUS STREETS

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield previously awarded a contract for certain road improvements with regard to a project known as the "2019 Capital Road Improvements – Various Streets" Project (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"), with said contract having been awarded to S. Brothers Inc. whose main offices are located in South River, New Jersey 08882 (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor"); and,

WHEREAS, David J. Testa, P.E., C.M.E., C.P.W.M. of Grotto Engineering and Associates, LLC (hereinafter referred to as the "Engineer"), on behalf of the Borough, by letter dated February 5, 2020, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the Borough Clerk and made a part hereof, has reviewed the Contractor's submission for Payment No. 3 (Final) in the total amount of Fifteen Thousand Six Hundred and Eighteen Dollars and Thirty-Six Cents (\$15,618.36), plus the release of any and all of the Contractor's retained funds held by the Borough for the Project; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Contract, the Contractor has submitted a one (1) year Maintenance Bond in the amount of Seventy-Eight Thousand Ninety-One Dollars and Seventy-Nine Cents (\$78,091.79), with an effective date of December 31, 2019; and,

WHEREAS, Director of Law/Borough Attorney Eric M. Bernstein, Esq. and the offices of Eric M. Bernstein & Associates, L.L.C. have reviewed the Engineer's and the Contractor's submissions and accept same based on the recommendations of the Engineer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the request for Partial Payment No. 3 (Final) and the Closeout of the Project known as 2019 Capital Road Improvements – Various Streets, is approved with S. Brothers, Inc. whose main offices are located in South River, New Jersey 08882, in the total amount of Fifteen Thousand Six Hundred and Eighteen Dollars and Thirty-Six Cents (\$15,618.36), plus the release of any and all of the Contractor's retained funds held by the Borough for the Project, which Final Payment Request and Closeout request is incorporated herein by reference as if same was fully set forth within and payment for same is authorized to be made to the Contractor, without the need for any further action of this Borough Council; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be subject to the Certification of the Borough's Chief Financial Officer as to the availability of funds for payment for same; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and the Borough Clerk to sign and/or execute all necessary documents to close out the Project and issue Payment No. 3 (Final).
