**RESOLUTION NO. 03-09-20-03a** RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH PLAINFIELD AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH CLERK TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH EXTRA DUTY SOLUTIONS FOR THE PROVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES OF EXTRANEOUS POLICE EMPLOYMENT

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield promulgated a Request for Proposals (RFP) for the provision of administrative services of extraneous police employment (hereinafter referred to as "Project); and,

WHEREAS, the Borough received one (1) proposal for the Project from Extra Duty Solutions on February 25, 2020, in which it proposes pricing for the Project as follows:

A seven percent (7%) administration fee will be added to all extra duty invoices. The vendor who will be paying for the detail will pay the fee. North Plainfield Board of Education

events and Borough annual events will not be charged an administration fee. If the Borough chooses to use Jivasoft's active duty scheduling software, an additional one percent (1%) will be added to the administration fee for the full setup, use and hosting of the software.

WHEREAS, the Borough Attorney and the Chief of Police have reviewed the proposal and recommend the award of the contract to Extra Duty Solutions as the lowest proposer for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the Borough Council does hereby approve the awarding of a contract for the Project set forth above to Extra Duty Solutions in accordance with its proposal.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and the Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and/or execute an Agreement with Extra Duty Solutions without the need for any further action of this Borough Council as to the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award of this Contract shall be subject to the Certification of the Borough's Chief Financial Officer as to the availability of funds for payment for same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award is made pursuant to and consistent with the Local Public Contracts Laws of the State of New Jersey.

## PLAINFIELD FIRE DIVISION (PFD) AND SOUTH PLAINFIELD FIRE DEPARTMENT (SPFD) FOR FY2019 FEMA AFG (ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTER GRANT) PROGRAM ON BEHALF OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH PLAINFIELD

WHEREAS, FEMA has available funds through The Assistance to Firefighters Grant ("AFG") program 2019 which supports Regional Projects that enhance the operational safety of established automatic mutual aid agreements for the public and firefighters from fire and related hazard; and

WHEREAS, the NORTH PLAINFIELD FIRE DEPARTMENT (NPFD) has a need for technical rescue equipment, a trailer and specialized training; and the PFD and SPFD also have the same need for this equipment and training, these departments have established a committee to develop a course of action to achieve the goals and objectives of the regional AFG program; and

WHEREAS, the NPFD desires to enter into a joint application with both the PFD and SPFD to obtain this training and specialized equipment through this committee and the regional FEMA AFG application to obtain funding for same; and

WHEREAS, the full amount of the request is \$457,432.60 and the FEMA grant will cover 90% of that amount, with the difference of approximately \$45,743.25 to be shared equally between NPFD, PFD and SPFD of approximately \$15,247.75 each; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, that the North Plainfield Fire Department is authorized to enter into a joint application with the City of Plainfield Fire Division and the South Plainfield Fire Department for FY2019 Assistance to Firefighters Grant and execute any and all agreements and/or take any other action on behalf of the Borough that becomes necessary during the application for the AFG and accepts the AFG should they be granted without any further action by the this Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the NPFD be granted the AFG funding, the Borough of North Plainfield shall be responsible for approximately \$15,247.75
