The current financial climate makes the interest rates higher than what they were at the start of 2023. Therefore, the Authority will exceed its interest income for the year. He has spoken with Mr. Snyder, and they discussed a few things that can be done in addition to what we are currently doing (short-term Notes, etc...). That is a trend that will go throughout the year. Mr. Snyder elaborated a little more on this subject matter and noted his negotiation with the bank, to get the interest rate raised on PARSA's account.

The exception is, PARSA is already doing it. Because we are already doing it, that takes us off the contention for the money.


