<p>Constitutional Amendment to Permit Casino Gambling in Two Counties Other Than Atlantic County</p> <p>Do you approve amending the Constitution to permit casino gambling in two additional counties in this State? At present, casino gambling is allowed only in Atlantic City in Atlantic County. Only one casino in each of the two counties would be permitted. Each casino is to be located in a town that is at least 72 miles from Atlantic City. The amendment would allow certain persons to apply first for a casino license.</p> <p>Interpretive Statement</p> <p>At present, casino gambling is allowed only in Atlantic City in Atlantic County. This amendment would allow the Legislature to pass laws to permit casino gambling to take place in two other counties in this State. Only one casino in each of the two counties would be permitted. Each casino is to be located in a town that is at least 72 miles from Atlantic City. The amendment would allow certain persons to apply first for a casino license. The laws passed by the Legislature would provide for the location and type of casinos and the licensing and taxing of the operation and equipment. The amendment provides that the State's share of revenue from the operation of the two casinos and of the casinos in Atlantic City would be used for programs and property tax relief for senior citizens and disabled residents. It would also be used for the recovery, stabilization, or improvement of Atlantic City and other purposes as provided by law. Lesser portions would be used to aid the thoroughbred and standardbred horsemen in this State and each town and county in which a casino is located.</p>	<p>Constitutional Amendment to Dedicate Additional Revenues to State Transportation System</p> <p>Do you approve amending the Constitution to dedicate all revenue from the State motor fuels tax and petroleum products gross receipts tax to the Transportation Trust Fund?</p> <p>This amendment would provide that an additional three cents of the current motor fuels tax on diesel fuel, which is not dedicated for transportation purposes, be dedicated to the Transportation Trust Fund. In doing so, the entire State tax on diesel fuel would be used for transportation purposes. The entire State tax on gasoline is currently dedicated to the Transportation Trust Fund and used for transportation purposes. The amendment would also provide that all of the revenue from the current State tax on petroleum products gross receipts be dedicated to the Transportation Trust Fund. In doing so, the entire State tax on petroleum products gross receipts would be used for transportation purposes. This amendment does not change the current tax on motor fuels or petroleum products gross receipts.</p> <p>Interpretive Statement</p> <p>This amendment would dedicate all of the revenue from the State tax on motor fuels to the Transportation Trust Fund. The current dedication is 10.5 cents per gallon on gasoline and diesel fuel. The amendment would include an additional three cents of the tax on diesel fuel that is not currently dedicated. The total revenue from the tax on motor fuels this fiscal year is estimated to be \$541 million. The amendment also dedicates all of the revenue from the tax on gross receipts of the sale of petroleum products to the Transportation Trust Fund. The current minimum dedication is \$200 million per year. This fiscal year, the revenue from the tax on gross receipts of the sale of petroleum products is estimated to be \$215 million. The amendment does not change the current tax on motor fuels or petroleum products gross receipts. The dedication to the Transportation Trust Fund ensures that the revenue is only used for transportation purposes.</p>

INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING

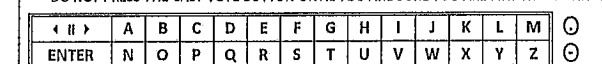
- Press the square to the right of the candidate of your choice. A green arrow will appear signifying your selection.
- To vote in favor of a question, press the square to the right of the word "YES." To vote against it, press the square to the right of the word "NO." A green arrow \leftarrow will appear next to your selection.
- To change any selection, press the square again. The green arrow will disappear and you may make a new selection.
- After you have completed all your selections, then press the cast vote button located in the lower right hand corner of the machine. This electronically records all of your votes.
- Part the curtains and exit the voting booth.

WARNING that an improperly cast write-in vote will be void and not counted. When choosing a personal choice (write-in), whatever office you choose to put in a personal choice for, that is the only office to which the vote will be counted. Any improperly cast vote will not be counted. Please read the face of the ballot carefully before taking this option. Should you have any questions regarding the personal choice, please ask the district board worker before entering the voting booth.

PERSONAL CHOICE (WRITE-IN) INSTRUCTIONS

The following is a step-by-step procedure for casting a write-in vote.

- UPON ENTERING THE VOTING BOOTH, LOCATE THE OFFICE YOU WISH TO VOTE FOR (OFFICES WILL BE LISTED TO THE LEFT OF THE BALLOT) AND FOLLOW THIS ROW ACROSS TO THE PERSONAL CHOICE COLUMN AND PRESS THE BUTTON.
 - A GREEN ARROW \leftarrow WILL BEGIN TO FLASH. (NOTE: THE "←" WILL CONTINUE TO FLASH UNTIL THE WRITE-IN IS COMPLETED).
 - AT THE BOTTOM OF THE BALLOT IS THE MAROON WRITE-IN KEYPAD, WHICH IS APPROXIMATELY WAIST HIGH. TYPE IN THE FIRST NAME OF THE CANDIDATE FOR WHOM YOU WISH TO VOTE. USE THE ARROW KEY FOR THE SPACE. THEN TYPE IN THE LAST NAME. NOW PRESS "ENTER" WHICH IS LOCATED ON THE PAD.
- IF AN ERROR ON THE WRITE-IN IS MADE - BEFORE YOU PRESS "ENTER" ON THE WRITE-IN KEYPAD - PRESS THE ARROW KEY TO THE LEFT UNTIL THE ERROR IS CLEARED AND THEN RE-TYPE THE NAME. TO MAKE A SPACE, PRESS THE ARROW KEY TO THE RIGHT.
- AFTER YOU HAVE COMPLETED VOTING THE ENTIRE BALLOT, PRESS THE ORANGE "CAST VOTE" BUTTON LOCATED ON YOUR LOWER RIGHT-HAND SIDE.
- DO NOT PRESS THE CAST VOTE BUTTON UNTIL YOU ARE SURE YOU ARE FINISHED VOTING.
