Summer Playground Program

Thursday, June 25th - Wednesday, August 12th

Summer Playgrounds are open to North Plainfield residents <u>only</u> for children 5 to 13 years old. All participants at all sites should bring a water bottle and snack with their name clearly written on bag. Full day campers should bring a lunch.

East End	1/2 Day	9 am - Noon	Weather Permitting

^{*}The 9 – 3 pm is a Pilot Program for all day camp.

Note: Each site will have age appropriate field trips for an extra charge.

Can my child attend more than one camp? Yes, this open door policy has not changed. Your child can attend different camps on different days. Simply register once and pay the appropriate fee. However, your child MUST have a completed Emergency form at each location that he/she attends.

How much does it cost? 1/2 day session is \$25. Full day (9 am – 3 pm) session is \$50.

How do I register my child(ren)? Go to the Recreation website to download registration forms at http://www.northplainfield.org/Departments/Recreation.htm on or after June 21st and bring in-person to one of the camp sites. Forms will also be available on-site. Registration begins June 25th at all playground locations. We will continue to register children all summer long. There is no Pre-Registration.

What's the difference between sites?

Vermeule Park. <u>1/2 Day.</u> Hours: 9 am – 12 pm, M-F. Ages 5-8. Rain or Shine. NO CAMP ON JULY 3RD. This year the camp will use the Senior Center when it's raining or too hot to be outside. Activities at this site include: arts and crafts, playground equipment, swings, board games, movies, and outdoor sports play.

Middle School. Full Day. Hours: 9 am - 3 pm, M-F. Ages 5-13. Rain or Shine. NO CAMP ON JULY 3rd. This is a new Pilot Program and the first time that N. Plainfield REC is offering a 6-hour camp. Campers will be inside if it's raining or it's too hot to be outside. Activities include: arts and crafts, board games, movies, outdoor sports play and inside gym for basketball, etc.

East End. ½ Day. Hours: 9 am – 12 pm, M-F. Ages 5-13. Weather Permitting. NO CAMP ON JULY 3rd. Only AM session will be offered this year at East End since no inside facilities are available for use. A separate Tennis Clinic will also be offered at this site, run by an outside company through NP Recreation for an additional cost. Activities include: arts and crafts, board games, and outdoor sports play. Registrants may go to one of the other sites based on their age if East End is closed due to weather.

Look for these additional summer programs in N. Plainfield: Tennis Clinics, All Sports Week Camp at end of August, and Ironman Soccer Camp
